

RESOLUTION NO. 137-14

A RESOLUTION COMMITTING TO CONSTRUCT FRONTAGE ROADS ALONG THE NEW NORTHEAST OKLAHOMA COUNTY LOOP TURNPIKE

WHEREAS on October 29, 2015, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority announced their plans to develop a Northeast Oklahoma County Loop Turnpike;

WHEREAS the Northeast Oklahoma County Loop Turnpike will connect I-40 to I-44 and will be comprised of 19 miles running north and south paralleling Luther Road, more or less, and 14 of those miles are located within the jurisdiction of Unincorporated Oklahoma County;

WHEREAS the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority has offered to purchase the necessary right-of-way to construct frontage roads along the route. Said right-of-way will be transferred to Oklahoma County as owner;

WHEREAS in accordance with Title 69 O.S. §.646, Oklahoma County may lay out new roads by Resolution, and the County hereby commits to construct frontage roads from SE 29th Street to Reno Avenue and U.S. 62 to I-44; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as a reflection of this partnership between Oklahoma County and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority will purchase the necessary right-of-way and the Oklahoma County Board of County Commissioners commits to pursue the construction of the frontage roads in stages along the Northeast Oklahoma County Loop Turnpike.
